# Make a bark rubbing!

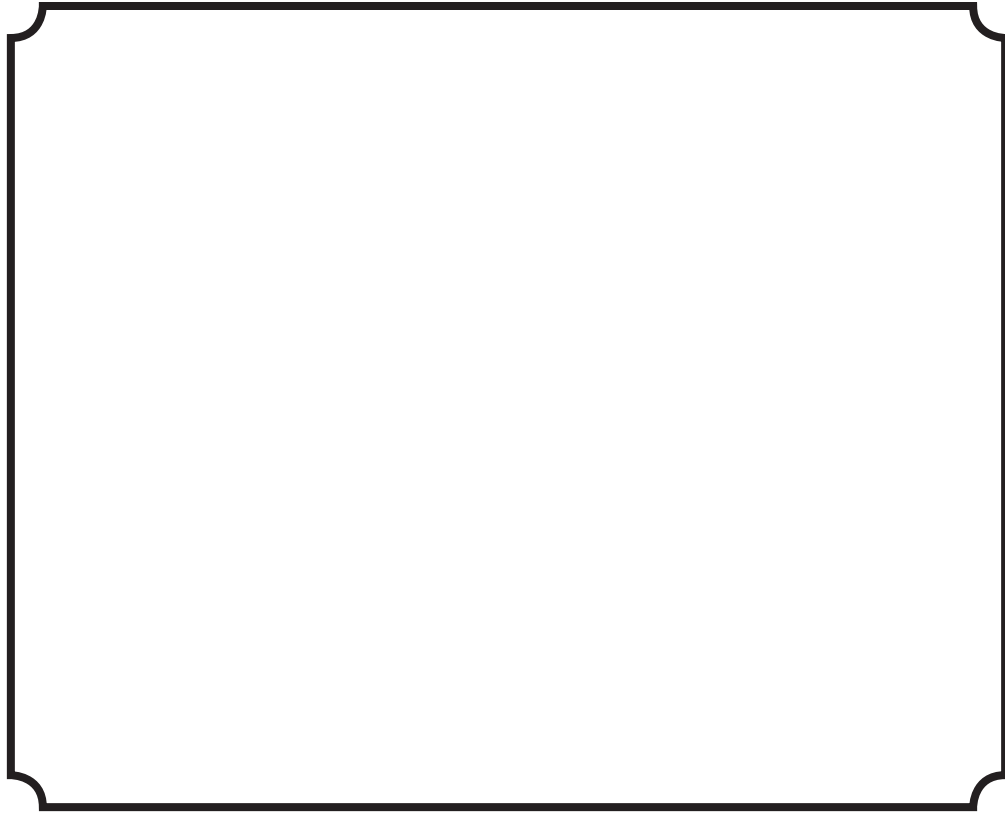


## What you will need:

## What to do:

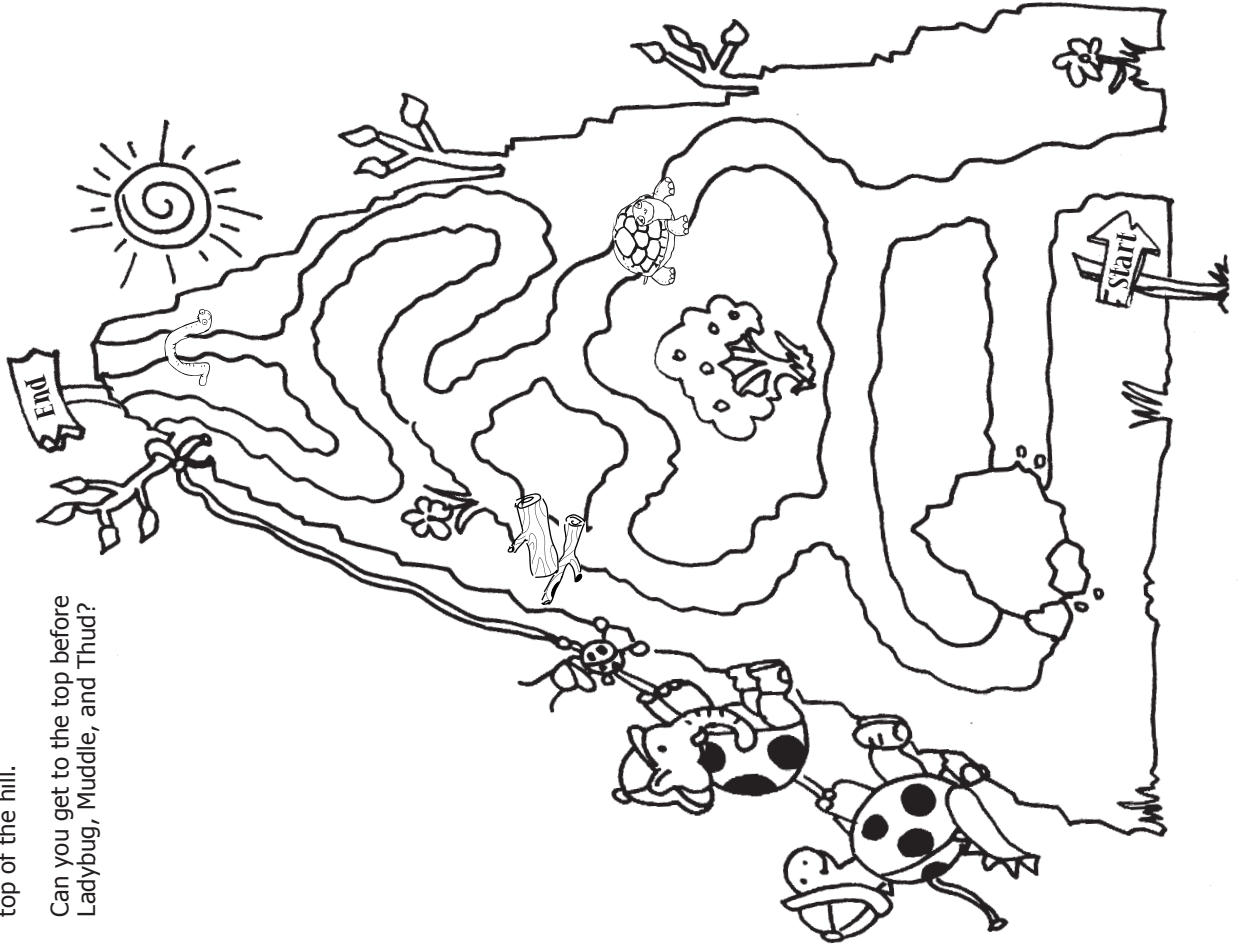
- 1. Hold the paper onto the bark of the tree.

# Ant fingerprints!

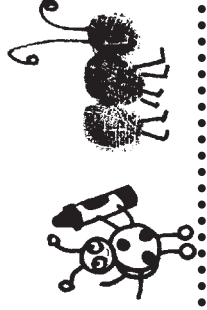
Add a few fingerprint ants to the picnic picture on the opposite page.

- black crayon

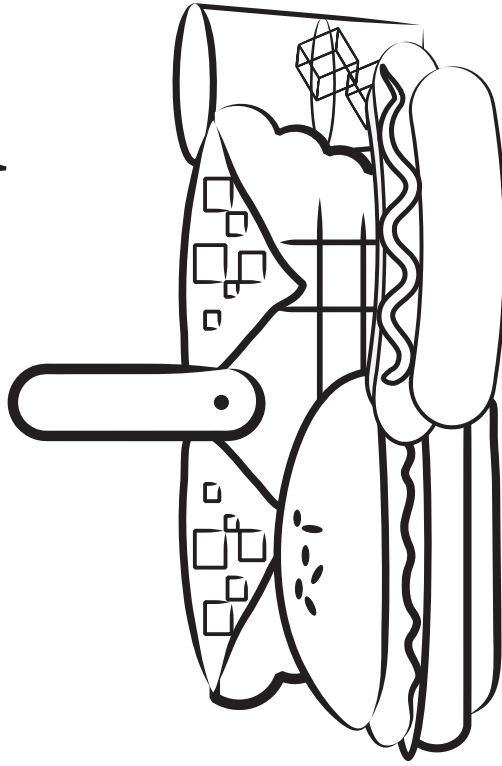
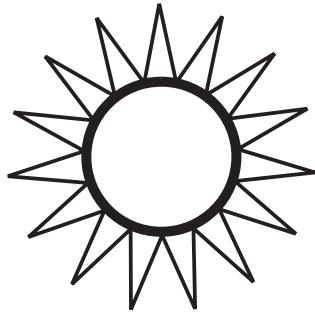
## What to do:



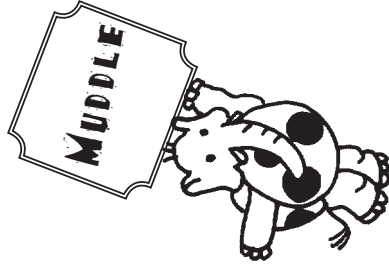
# Write your name in sand!

- sand

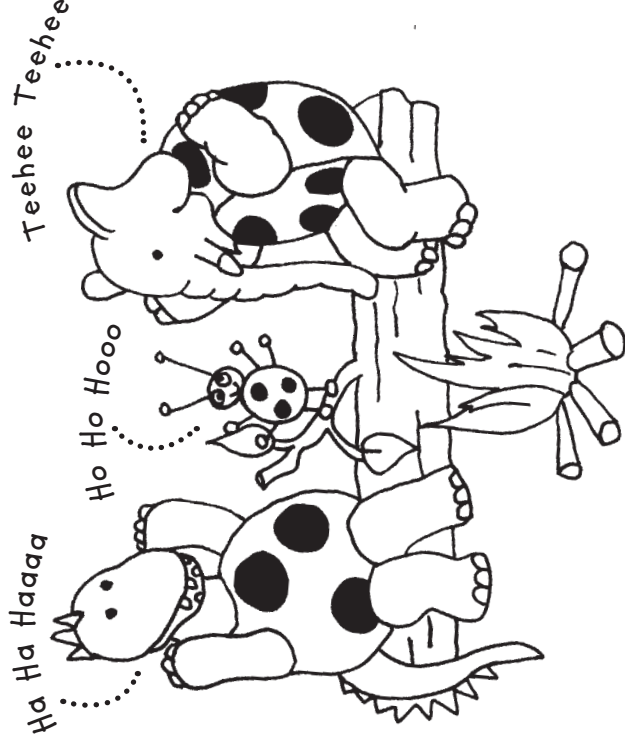
## What to do:
